STEPS INVOLVED IN TEACHING SEX EDUCATION

LEARNING OUTCOME

The participants will understand at the end of the training, the steps involved in teaching sex education to their child(ren)/adult.

INTRODUCTION

As your child get older and began to explore your face with his hands as all babies do, you can interact with him/her by saying things like "Mommy's nose" or "Daddy's eyes." These early interactions may seem insignificant at the time; but in reality, they could not have been more important in helping your baby achieve certain milestones, including language development and of course, identification of body parts.

INTRODUCTION

Although most children aren't able to verbally identify more than three or four body parts before their second birthday, there are plenty of things you can do to help prepare your little one for this important milestone, and you can start as early as infancy.



TEACHING NON SENSITIVE PARTS OF THE BODY

- Play interactive games with your youngster, taking turns pointing to specific body parts. For example, you can first point to your nose, and then say, "Now, can Peter touch his nose?" Repeat this activity for several different body parts.
- If your child has a favorite baby doll then, you can use it as a learning tool, pointing to the arms, legs, feet, etc.
- Music has always been a creative way to get children involved in learning. Try singing some songs together about body parts.

TEACHING NON SENSITIVE PARTS OF THE BODY

Whichever method you use to help your child begin to recognize the parts of her body, remember not to force the issue. The learning process should always be fun, especially at this young age.







